



Possible Partnership Activities

1. Talk to Head teacher to Head teacher via email
2. Teacher to teacher or student to student communications via email or letter
3. Video Conferencing school to school by arrangement via BEFSA with Fort Hare University and OCC ICT department
4. Share School Improvement Plans to identify common areas of interest
5. Share resources on different curriculum areas
6. Share activities for Duke Of Edinburgh Award Scheme and The President's Award
7. Identify an International News Page in your School Newsletter sharing information about and activities relating to your partner school
8. Identify an International Notice board in the school to share photographs and raise awareness of school activities
9. Identify one class or year group to link with a class in your partner school
10. Share information on different school activities/curriculum areas e.g. comparing cultures, religions, a focus and increased awareness on world poverty and aids, ideas for vegetable gardens, sharing ideas on food and nutrition, swapping recipes, music, dance and drama, poetry and literature, heritage and tourism
11. Fund raising activities e.g. stationery box for a class, variety of activities to raise funds for a new door/electricity/ IT equipment for your partner school
12. Sending any redundant school equipment (but still in working order!) to your partner school e.g. sports equipment, musical instruments, computers (BEFSA will co-ordinate the shipping of such items)
13. Set up a student body to work with the International teacher at the school
14. Hold a "South Africa" evening for parents and the community to raise awareness
15. Musical/drama/dance evenings to fund raise
16. Facebook could become a communication network as the SA Schools become more IT literate
17. Exchange visit for teachers and students
18. Email other UK schools to share or combine ideas too!
